Endosyms have hidden among the human race since the beginning of time. The idea of a human possessed by a demon crosses all religions. But with endosyms, possession is not the case—the endosym is actually *the assimilation of a demon and human into one body, with the DNA of both creatures intermixed*.

Endosyms are stronger and smarter than either of the two individual creatures. The outward appearance of an endosym is similar to a normal human. And, only a few humans out of the 7 billion that inhabit the planet have the ability to see the demon within the man.
